What do I need to have with me to get a Husky One Card (UConn ID)?

A photo ID such as a drivers license, passport, or some other official picture ID. Employees will also need to bring a copy of their payroll authorization, a letter from their Department, or the paper card from Human Resources.

What do I do if I lose my ID?

If you lose your card, deactivate it via the website at www.onecard.Uconn.edu or call the One Card Office at 486-3129. If you find it, you can reactivate it on the website or in person at the One Card Office. Any meals or cash lost are not refundable, so make sure to deactivate your lost card immediately.

Do ID cards expire?

ID cards do not expire. You do not have to renew your card at the beginning of each year or each semester. Your card is valid for the entire time you are attending the University, unless your status changes (ex. from undergraduate to graduate).

What happens if my ID breaks?

Do not throw it out. Bring the broken card to the One Card Office to exchange it for a new one. All pieces of the broken ID are required to get a new ID free of charge.

Can my friends use my ID?

No. Your ID is yours to use only. If a person is caught using someone else's ID, the ID may be confiscated. This is to safeguard any value that may be on the card.

Can I pick up my friend's/ child's ID card?

No. The cardholder must be the person who picks up the ID.

What can I use my ID for?

The Husky One Card has many different functions. It is used as identification on campus for various functions and events, for meal plans (at Storrs), to take books out of the library, and purchases with **HUSKY Bucks** including laundry (Storrs) and library copying and printing.

What are Husky Bucks?

HUSKY Bucks is a debit account on your ID to make purchases at various locations on campus. You will need **HUSKY Bucks** to do Information Technology Center and Library copying and printing. How can I add Husky Bucks?

- Via credit card deposit (\$1 admin fee) at www.onecard.Uconn.edu
- The One Card Office at STORRS- (2nd floor of Wilbur Cross) by mail, in person, or by phone at 486-3129
- The Greater Hartford Campus Co-op- in person
- The Homer Babbidge Library (Storrs)(Computer and Copy Services)- cash only. Cash Value Terminal located on the first floor.

Cash cannot be taken out of this account. Refunds are only issued upon request if the student is graduating or has separated from the University.
